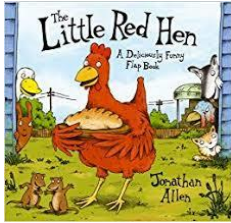


Nursery.

The Little Red Hen.

Reading.

Listen to the story of 'The Little Red Hen'. (You Tube. Super Simple TV.)

Can you retell the story?

Can you use character voices?

Do you think the animals were being kind?

How can you help at home?

Could you help wash the dishes? What will you wash first? How many spoons did you wash?



Writing.

Can you make a picture book of the little red hen story?

What happened first, next and at the end?

Practise writing your name on your book. You are the author!

Listening games.

Spend 1 minute just listening!

What can you hear? What makes that sound? Can you make that sound?

Sound in a box! Fill a shoe box or a bag with different objects that make a noise, e.g. keys, a crisp packet, a paper bag, squeaky toy etc.

Let your child guess what it is.

Maths.

Mathletics! Can you do 10 jumps, 9 hops, 8 skips.....?

Keep counting everyday. How many plates are on the dinner table? How many socks are in your drawer? How many windows are in your home? How many footsteps are there from your bedroom to the kitchen?

Try the spring I spy counting sheet attached.

Creative fun!

Can you make up a dance routine to your favourite song?



Can you teach your grown up the dance?

Build a reading den. Invite your grown up into the den and share a story with them!
