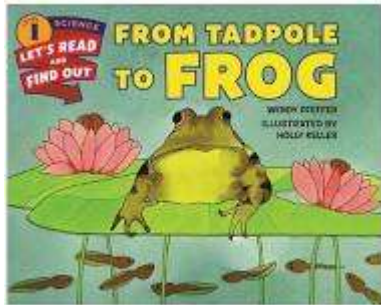


Nursery.

Reading.

If you have the book, share the story of 'From tadpole to Frog' or listen to the story on You Tube.

Tell your grown up about what happened to the tadpole.

Writing.

You have been learning all about things that grow through the books you have been looking at over the last few weeks.

Can you draw five things that grow?

Which has been your favourite book? (The little red hen, The very hungry caterpillar, Oliver's vegetables, Jack and the beanstalk or From tadpole to frog?)

Listening games and Phonics.

Play the rhyming words game attached. Say the words out loud.

Can you find the odd one out?

Try some of the oral blending and segmenting games attached.

Maths.

Warm up! Write on small pieces of paper the numbers 1 to 10. Ask your grown up to hide them around the room. Can you find them all? Can you put them in order?

All about money. Ask your grown up for some coins. Can you sort them into the different values?

How many have you got of each coin?

Topic.

Use the life cycle of a frog photo pack to explain to your grown up what happens to tadpoles.
