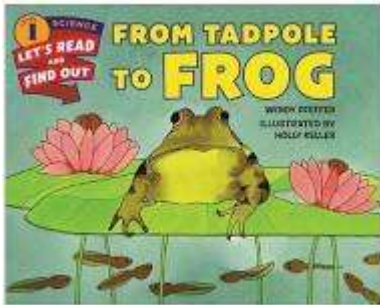

**Shapes.** Use the attached power point to learn more about shapes. Tell your grown up what have you learnt by the end of it?
