



- 1) a) 1100 g
- b) 300g
- c) week 1

- 1) a) 4 weeks and 5 weeks
- b) 17.5kg
- c) $20.5\text{kg} - 5.3\text{kg} = 15.2\text{kg}$
- d) $(8\text{kg} - 1.7\text{kg}) + (8.5\text{kg} - 2.6\text{kg}) = 12.2\text{kg}$
- 2) He has read where the lines cross over as combined mass. Greg should add together the mass of both puppies.
($9.5\text{kg} + 9.5\text{kg} = 19\text{kg}$)



- 1) e.g. distance walked by two dogs over 40 minutes.
e.g. Labrador and poodle
- 2) e.g. The Labrador walked on a lead for 15 minutes then ran through the park. After 25 minutes, it had a 5-minute rest (maybe its owner was playing on the swings!) before steadily walking home.
