

# CATCH A LOT

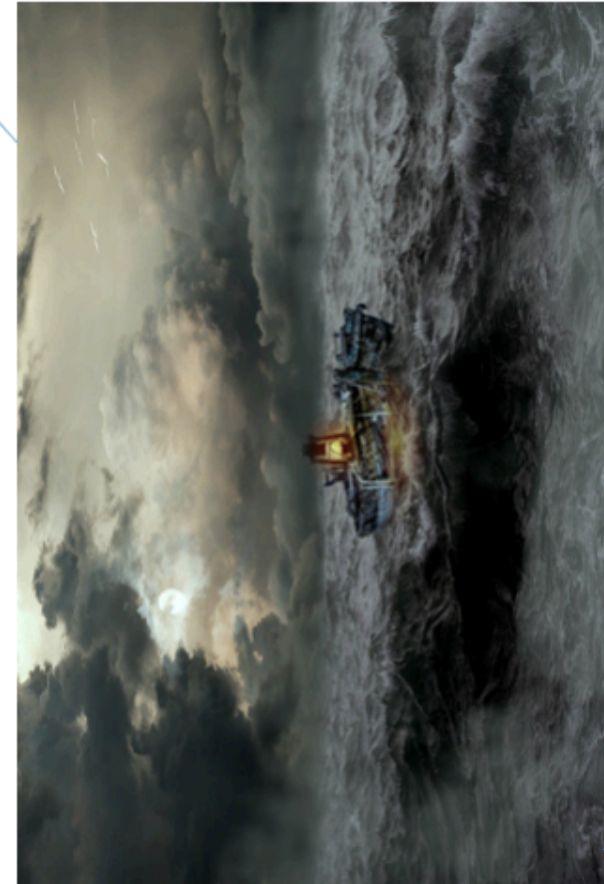
